



Northwest Academy of Health Sciences: Reopening Information

Introductory Statement: Northwest Academy’s return to in-person learning will begin with Phase 3 on March 15, 2021. Each family that has selected in-person learning, their student will be in school two-days a week and virtual for three days that same week.

<p>Arrival & Dismissal Procedures:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will enter through the main lobby from the front bus loop. • Students will be dismissed through the main lobby and meet their bus in the front bus loop. Buses will depart both the front lots. • No vehicles outside of busses are permitted in the bus loop during arrival or departure. Parents should remain in their vehicles during drop off/pick up and use of the parking lots to load/unload students. 	<p>Face Covering:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Face coverings are required for all persons in a BCPS facility or vehicle as well as on BCPS property. Face coverings are required during transportation to/from school on a bus as well as outdoors on campuses. • Each school, office, and school bus will have a supply of disposable face coverings for students and employees who forget their face covering or whose face covering becomes soiled or damaged.
<p>Screening & Stay Home When Appropriate:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Everyone must screen themselves daily for symptoms of COVID-19. • Remain home if you have symptoms, confirmed COVID-19 illness, had recent contact with a person with COVID-19 and/or awaiting test results. 	<p>Social Distancing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Classroom furniture is arranged to provide 6-foot separation between students, when possible. • Reduce gathering of students in any area – refer to changes in arrival and dismissal procedures and movement in the hallways.
<p>Hand Hygiene:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Handwashing or use of hand sanitizer to includes before/after meals, upon arrival to schools’ offices and home, before and after use of any shared items, after use of the restroom, after sneezing/coughing and any time hands are contaminated. 	<p>Breakfast & Lunch:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cafeteria furniture is arranged to provide 6-foot separation between students, air filtration and/or plexiglass shields. • Handwashing and use of hand sanitizer to include before and after meals, upon arrival to schools’ cafeteria. • Breakfast and Lunch will be provided to all students at no cost. There will be no exchange of cash.
<p>Supplies & Devices:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students should bring a fully charged student device, earbuds, and their device charger to school daily. • Students should bring any other supplies they require for learning. There will be no shared supplies. • Students will not have access to lockers or locker rooms 	<p>Visitors:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To visit a BCPS school, visitors must have an appointment. • All visits will be conducted remotely or outside, unless in the case of emergency. • Any indoor visitors will be required to wear a face coverings and practice social distancing. • The number of people admitted to the building will be limited.
<p>Sign Up for In-Person (Hybrid) Learning:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To opt-in to hybrid instruction families must complete the <u>Return to In School Hybrid Learning Form</u> on our website. • If the form is not completed, students must continue with fully virtual instruction. • Students that come to school without completing the form, must return home to continue with virtual instruction.
