23-24 Uniform Expectations- All students will be in uniform daily.

- Students will wear the uniform every day, unless otherwise noted and administrative communication is provided to families for special events.
- Students must be in uniform for field trips, assemblies, and all after-school activities (unless otherwise communicated by school personnel).

^{*}Bottoms should be khaki in color (light tan) and fabric. No sweatpants, jeans, or leggings are permitted.

^{*}Bottoms should be securely positioned on waist, with a belt as needed.

^{*}Students may wear solid-colored cardigans, crewneck sweatshirts or sweaters may be worn in cold-weather months, but they must correspond with the class colors. Students may also elect purchase NAHS Expansion wear for cold weather.

- Students will be asked to change if they are not in uniform and will be permitted to wear clean donated uniforms if available.
- Phone call will be made home for uniform infractions and a school consequence (i.e. detention, demerit, loss of incentive, etc.) will be provided.

The following items are PROHIBITED- Please review CAREFULLY with your student!

- Hooded Attire- this includes hoodie sweatshirts, henleys, jackets, etc. There will be
 no exception or opportunity for students to wear hooded attire for ANY reason
 during the school year.
- Coats (should be stored in locker during the school day)
- Shirts without a collar
- Hats, Bandanas, du-rags, and bonnets, skullcaps, velcro headwraps, etxc no headwear will be permitted at any time during the school year. The ONLY exception will be headwear worn for religious purpose.
- Blankets- these may NOT be brought to school for any reason.
- Shorts and skirts shorter than at or below fingertips.
- Sweatpants- all pants MUST be khaki color and material, no sweats, joggers, leggings, etc. Will be permitted (except PE uniforms).

Footwear Restrictions

Because they pose a potential safety hazard to our students, the following shoes are not permitted:

- Heelys (shoes with removable wheels in the heel)
- Flip Flops
- Shower Shoes
- Athletic Slippers/Slides
- House Slippers
- Open-Toed Shoes
- Crocs

Uniforms will be expected on August 28, so please order early!
